Notes 1. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the tax year at the basic rate.

- 2. If in future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the charity reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note 4).
- 3. If you pay tax at the highest rate, you can claim further tax relief in your Self-Assessment tax return.
- 4. You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying the charity.
- 5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask the charity or you can ask your local tax office for appropriate information.
- 6. Please notify the charity if you change your name or address.
